


Continuous Operation of Business


7.40 Types of liquor license of "Class A", "Class B" and or "Class C" license issued to a person and that is not actively using such license in a business for a period of 4 months shall constitute an abandonment of such licenses. This shall be cause of revocation. Upon knowledge of unused license , the Town Clerk shall notify the license holder by certified mail that the license is deemed revoked. The license holder shall deliver the license and surrender the license to the Town Clerk.


7.41 In the event the holder of said license has undue hardship or unusual circumstances beyond the license holder's control, the license holder can request an extension of 4 months from the Osborn Town Board. It will be required after 2 months into the extension that said license holder should report in person at the monthly board meeting the progress being made. The decision of the Osborn Town Board shall be final and binding.
